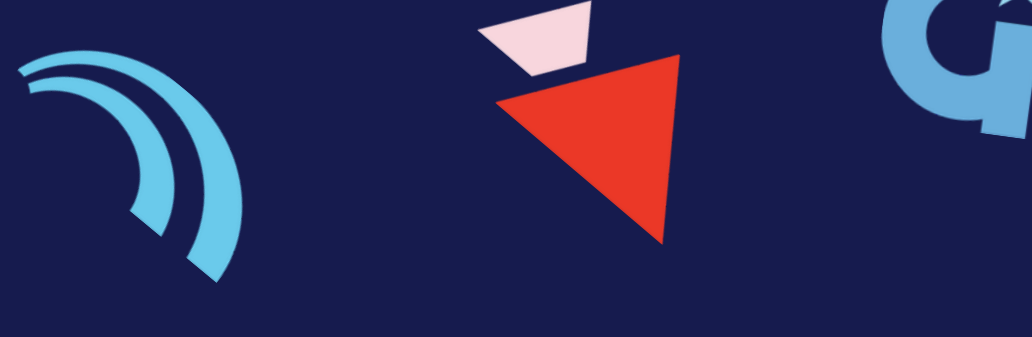

WELCOME!

Nether Auchendrane Activity Centre is a purpose built residential centre and campsite just outside of Alloway, Ayr which is suitable for short breaks with youth groups and other organisations.

The site consists of 2 connecting buildings, one is the main house with a fully fitted kitchen for large scale cooking and dining, a bathroom and 2 dormitories sleeping 12 in each, a 2 bed room with a disabled access ensuite and a leaders room which sleeps 4 people.

The annex consists of a smaller activity room, a kitchen and a large bathroom. This is included in all campsite bookings.



Campsite

The campsite includes 2 water taps, a fully stocked woodshed, a outdoor classroom and a campfire circle.

Parking

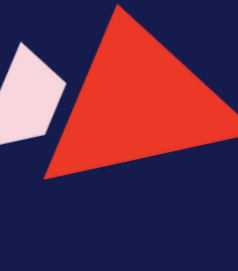
We have a small car park which is accessed by a single track road through a private estate.

Payment information

Deposit terms

At the time of booking confirmation a deposit of £100 must be paid, this includes a £50 security deposit which will be returned on a satisfactory completion of the checkout inspection list.

We reserve the right to retain this in part or whole based upon the centre being left in a less than satisfactory condition.

Deposit must be paid within 14 days of booking being confirmed by Nether Auchendrane. Until payment has been received booking is in provisional booking status.

Balance

All balances must be paid 14 days before the commencement of your stay.

Cancellations of bookings

We appreciate that unforeseen circumstances occur, If you have to fully cancel your booking there may be a charge. Please see below our cancellation policy

If you cancel your booking within 60 days of the start date you will lose your deposit but will not have to pay the balance.

If you cancel your booking with less than 30 days notice you will be required to pay a percentage of the cost of your stay.

If we have to cancel your booking due to unforeseen circumstances you will be fully refunded and have the right to reschedule your booking at a later date. Examples of such are below

- We have advised you of an upcoming change on site which means the booking is not suitable
- We have advised you of an error with pricing and you do not wish to go ahead.
- We need to cancel your booking due to events out of our control

ACCESS is from B7024. From Alloway village pass Burns Cottage on your right, then pass Brig O'Doon Hotel on your left, continue on the main road over the bridge and up the hill. Entrance to the site is at the top of the hill on the left. The road is single track with passing places. Turn left at the sign to the centre, and then turn right into the car park.

Site access

by car, minibus and buses no bigger than 20 seaters

If larger buses used then children and belongings need to be walked or transported by car from the turn off on the B7024.

Site Guidelines

We kindly ask that everyone who uses our site respects it by following a few guidelines.

- Vehicles do not sit with their engine on idle as it can be quite noisy for our neighbours.
- People car share where it is at all possible, this limits congestion on the narrow roads and in our small car park
- Respect our sites boundaries and do not go into our neighbours gardens
- The site is strictly a No Smoking/vaping site
- Sorry, no pets except registered assistance dogs.
- Soft shoes only indoors
- Use boards provided for posters. Please do not place anything on our walls
- Kitchen area for catering only – strictly no crafts in kitchen
- Bleach must not be used in kitchen sinks, toilets or shower cubicles due to our septic tank
- Do not flush tampons/sanitary towels down toilets – use bins provided, and dispose contents correctly
- Please switch off unnecessary lighting, help us look after our planet
- Record any accidents in our accident book in the kitchen and let us know.

SLEEPING ACCOMMODATION –

We have 2 dormitories with 6 double bunk beds (ie 12 people in each dorm),

1 room with 1 double bunk and en-suite wetroom (i.e. 2 people), 1 leader's room with 4 single beds and some comfortable seating.

A fitted single bed sheet

CAMPSITE

Our campsite can comfortably accommodate up to 200 people, depending on tent size. We do have some lightweight tents available on request.

We also have camping equipment for a small hire charge as well.

Insurance
